PARTICIPANTS

Meet every 2-3 months for 2 hours 8 people in total, one third out of town physicians

- Chief of staff
- FEI coordinator
- Town recruiter
- The same 1-2 physicians from each of the three clinics in town

BENEFITS OF THE SMALL GROUP

- Delve deep into topics
- Further division of labour with subgroups of 1 or 2 physicians
- Have conversations about difficult, sensitive and complicated topics
- Reach a consensus and maintain cohesiveness of a diverse group of practicing physicians
